1. Seek help

- You can speak with your school/ college SENCO
- You can get in touch with **SENDIASS Rutland** for support.



2. Request the changes

- Ask the Local Authority to make the changes
- You can put your complaint in writing or an email, using the word 'complaint'
- You can ask someone like a SENCO or SENDIASS Rutland to support you with this
- Be clear about all the issues you want resolved
- State what you want to happen
- Give a reasonable time by which you would like a response

3. Ask for Mediation or Disagreement Resolution

You can get in touch with Global Mediation and ask for a meeting with everybody involved. The service is free and confidential and is a good way of making **your voice** heard to everyone involved. You can choose whether to use this or not.



4. Appeal the Decision

You can ask **SENDIASS Rutland to help you**. You must still get a certificate from **Global Mediation** whether you take it or not to show that you have 'considered' it. You can appeal against many different things such as:

- What is written or not written in your plan
- The school/ college or **type** of school/ college it says
- When information is incorrect

The 1st Tier Tribunal will look at all evidence from both sides and make a decision. This might take a while as it is not a quick process.
